

Bible study groups begin at 10:00am and meet in a variety of locations (see map below). You're invited to attend any of the groups (there's a wide variety of topics being studied).



Whether you're a member or a guest, you're invited to attend any of the study groups:

- A Conversation About the Scriptures: Come join us for a lively discussion as we study the Gospel of John. The Gospel of John was written to prove that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. As an eyewitness to the love and power displayed in the life and teachings of Jesus, John gives us an up-close and personal look at Christ's identity. He shows us that Jesus, though fully God, came in the flesh to distinctly and accurately reveal God, and that Christ is the source of eternal life to all who believe in him.
